

Born in 1685, Handel and Bach never met, but they came close, and both studied with the great Dietrich Buxtehude. Bach's solo alto Cantata 54 Widerstehe doch der Sünde is flanked by Buxtehude's joyful Cantata 4 Alles, was ihr tut, and Handel's virtuosic and fiery Dixit Dominus.
