Participants join outstanding professional vocal soloists and instrumentalists in performing the music rehearsed under the brilliant leadership of conductor Kathy Romey during the service of Evening Prayer which concludes *Bach-Tage*.

In 2023, the music will include Bach's cantata

Herr, gebe nicht ins Gericht mit deinem Knecht BWV 105

(Lord, do not enter into judgement with your servant),

a pivotal cantata from his first year in Leipzig, a year that would be climaxed by the premier of his St. John Passion.

We will also prepare and perform a delightful composition from the French baroque composer, Marc-Antoine Charpentier.

Conductor Kathy Romey is professor of choral conducting at the University of Minnesota, Artistic Director of The Minnesota Chorale, Chorus Master of the Oregon Bach Festival and the *Internationale Bachakademie Stuttgart*. We are privileged that she has been conductor of *Bach-Tage* since it's founding.

The *Bach-Tage* Orchestra players are all specialists in interpretation of Baroque music, performing on historical-replica instruments.
